This is a Job Analysis Study that allows us to define the knowledge, skills, and abilities required of the minimally competent practitioner. The job analysis study typically consists of two phases:

1. A panel of subject matter experts defines the responsibilities of the minimally competent professional
2. Individuals working in the profession evaluate and validate the responsibilities identified by the panel. The second phase is typically accomplished using a survey.

This study is conducted approximately every five years to make sure that the exam stays current with what is occurring in the field.

Another priority for ABCGN over the coming year is the re-accreditation process. ABCGN is accredited by the American Board of Nurse Specialties (ABNS); accreditation is awarded for 5 years and ours will expire in 2012.

It looks to be a busy and exciting year, and I look forward to serving as your president.

**Fall Certification Exam Registration Window Open  
Register by August 31 to Take the Certification Exam this Fall**

In today’s fast-paced, technology-driven healthcare field, it isn’t enough just to be a good nurse. To be competitive, you’ve got to keep up – and keeping up with modern nursing means getting certified. Encourage your staff and colleagues to register for the fall exam and get certified! The fall testing window runs from October 1-31, 2010.

Candidates can complete the application and submit payment all in one step with ABCGN’s new easy to use registration system. This system completely replaces the paper applications; all candidates must apply online. Once the application window closes on August 31, candidate will receive an email notice from our testing vendor, Castle Worldwide, with instructions on choosing a test site and date.

**Application Deadlines**

Candidates can apply for the exam during the three-month application window prior the exam:

**Fall 2011**

Registration Window - Online	June 1 - August 31
Registration Deadline - Online	August 31 11:59 p.m. CT
Examination Administration Window	October 1 - 31

**IMPORTANT NOTE: Once the application window closes, no further applications will be accepted for that testing cycle.**

The exam is only offered in the computer-based format in the fall. This convenient test option provides hundreds of locations for testers and a 30 day window in which to take the exam. ### **ABCGN Business Meeting Recap**

The Annual Business Meeting of the American Board of Certification for Gastroenterology Nurses was held on Sunday, May 8, at the SGNA Annual Course in Indianapolis, Indiana. President Barbara Schwant, BSN RN CGRN, opened the meeting by reviewing the year's accomplishments:

Treasurer Jeanie Ebbert, RN CGRN, presented the highlights of the audited financial statement for the ABCGN fiscal year ending December 31, 2010. She reported that in 2010, total revenue was \$427,687 and expenses totaled \$402,781, which resulted in a gain of \$24,906.

### **2011 ABCGN Bylaw Changes Approved**

Two amendments to the ABCGN Bylaws were proposed to the membership. Both were approved by the membership.

#### **1. Article IV. Sections 4.2.2 and 5. Election Procedures and Term**

Election of directors shall be by electronic ballot, with each member having one vote for each office.

*Rationale:* ABCGN conducts its voting via electronic ballot. These sections need to be cleaned up to reflect current practice.

#### **2. Article V. Board of Directors, Section 4. Annual Elections.**

Annual elections by the Board of Directors shall be conducted to elect the officers of the organization. Election of officers shall be by vote of the Board, by the Board members present at a meeting of the Board of Directors, with each Board member having one vote for each officer position to be filled. A plurality shall elect. In case of a tie for any office, the election shall be decided by a run-off election between the candidates. Results of elections shall be tabulated and communicated to members.

*Rationale:* The Board is moving into more of a strategic entity and developing additional committees to handle operational work. With additional committees in place, there won't be a need for such a large Board.

### **Certification/Recertification Review**

The purpose of the GI Specific Audit Committee is to review educational programs that have been approved for continuing education contact hours by a recognized ABCGN provider for determination of GI specific content.

The primary focus is for review of "Category 1" contact hours. These are hours that will be provided at a live seminar or workshop. These programs may have been sent through SGNA for contact hour approval or may be sent directly to ABCGN from an SGNA Region, a GI vendor, a hospital, or other healthcare sector. For a complete listing of all categories and their descriptions please see the ABCGN website.

The program is reviewed for the amount of GI Specific content. The entire course which includes course titles, descriptions, outlines, objectives, and time allotments is required for the committee member to review the program and make a decision as to the GI Specific time allowed for the program. Some presentations may be broken down into segments that are GI and other segments that are non-GI. This is all determined by the information provided by the submitter of the course. There are times when the reviewer will request additional information or need clarification as to the content of a program. This is time consuming both for the reviewer and the submitter. Therefore, it is essential that all required information be sent in with the initial submission. This will assist the reviewer to complete the request in a timely fashion.

As of the time of this writing there have been 70+ submissions for the year 2011 for review of GI Specific content. The Spring and Fall course times are the busiest. 2010 finished the year with a total 153 course submissions reviewed by ABCGN. All but 62 were our Regional SGNA Societies. The other 62 were from vendors, hospitals, and universities seeking our approval of GI Specific content in their programs. The GI Specific committee also reviewed the 2011 Annual SGNA Course which was just held in Indianapolis. The 2012 Annual Course content will be sent in mid-fall for us to review for GI content. This can be an involved process as programs are added or changed as the Course is developed.

The purpose of the Recertification Audit Committee is to review certification packets of candidates selected for audit. One out of every ten submissions must be audited per ABCGN requirements. The packets are sent to the committee member and reviewed for content of total hours and breakdown of the correct type of hours. With the five year renewal 100 total hours are required to be submitted.

Submission may be at the five year due date or by a per year submission. An applicant may also request a pre-review. Eighty of the required hours must be GI Specific and 40 of these are required to be at a "Category 1" live course/workshop. The committee member also verifies that the provider of the contact hours is an approved ABCGN provider. A complete provider list is available on the ABCGN web site in the Recertification Handbook link. Recertification tips are also available on our web site.

The Recertification Review Committee member may request additional documentation to support an application for renewal. Requests could be made for a program of a seminar/workshop, course descriptions from academic course work, and similar backup documentation. Complete, concise, and careful record keeping makes the review so much easier.

In May 2011 the GI Specific Audit and the Recertification Audit committees welcomed some new members. They had indicated their interest in volunteering by have filling out Willingness to Serve forms. They were appointed by the ABCGN president after completing the application process.
